

Chartering Overview

- Types of charters
 - Bareboat charters, optionally with a skipper for ½ or full day
 - Flotilla charters
 - Crewed charters (Skipper only or full crew)
 - Learn-to-Sail sailing school charters, ASA 101,103-4
- Charter companies
 - Vary in size
 - Really big (Moorings, Sunsail)
 - Smaller (Horizon, Tortola Marine Management)
 - Worldwide (Moorings) or local Area (Anacortes, San Juan Charters)
 - 1st Tier and 2nd Tier Companies (Moorings-Footloose)
 - Charter Broker services
 - Boatbound, etc.
 - Fronts for other companies (ABC for Horizon)



- *\$\$ Dollars vs. Speed
- *Sailboats [can be operated as a powerboat) are much cheaper for 2 reasons:
- 1. \$ charter costs per cabin are ½ of power
- 2. Fuel costs are less than ½ due to motor size, hull shape and speed.
- *That's why 9 of 10 yachts have been sail. We've sailed less than 5% of the time.

Charter Qualifications: What Do You Need?

What experience do I need?

The good news is, you don't need any formal certification. Just experience sailing on a similar sized boat, within about 5-7 feet, will be suitable. Based on the type of sailing conditions you're used to (i.e. body of water, tidal vs. non-tidal, long or short distances, etc.), we'll help you pick the best destination for you.

How Do I Qualify?

It is very easy to determine if you qualify for a yacht and destination. No formal certification is required for most of our destinations. Just complete our sailing resume and submit it on-line. We will inform you what size yacht you qualify to sail with us and which destinations are appropriate for your experience.

The Moorings

What experience is required to charter a boat?

Generally, we require that the person chartering the vessel has experience operating a boat of similar size (within three feet), displacement, and rig. As part of the reservation process we will talk with you about your experience. Our checkouts include a chart briefing, full systems checkout, and, if necessary, an underway check out. We want you to feel comfortable handling your yacht.

- Charter companies use their own forms
 - On-line resume
 - Fill out and mail or fax
- Sunsail and Moorings now ask about ASA sailing qualifications

Charter Resumes: What to Include

- Personal information
- Sailing experience
 - Have you bareboat chartered before?
 - Charter company, Size/type of boat, Location, Dates, Skipper or Crew?
 - Do you own or have you owned a boat?
 - Size/type of boat(s)
 - Years as a cruising skipper
 - Average number of days you sail each year
 - Primary sailing area(s) and size/type boats usually sailed
 - Experience: anchoring (bow anchor; two anchors; stern anchor; Med. moor), picking up mooring, docking, reefing, navigation, in 25+ knot winds, offshore
- Sailing courses/qualifications/certifications/sailing clubs
- Sailing references
- Any marine claims in past five years?

Cutting Charter Costs Other Good Deals

- ABC in Annapolis offers a 10% discount for new PSC Cruising Skippers
- Charter during lower demand periods
- Sleep aboard option before 1st night of the charter saves hotel cost and gets another night of vacation

Making It Happen Planning Your Charter

- Where to charter
 - Where do you want to go?
 - Prevailing sailing conditions
 - Weather
 - Degree of difficulty, <u>Tides & Currents</u>
 - More or less time sailing
 - Activities (sailing, shopping, nightlife, sightseeing, snorkeling, diving, and of course just "limin'")
- When to charter-mostly 1 week, or off-peak long weekends
 - Seasons (high, low, summer- fall hurricane season in East Coast-Caribbean)
- Who to go with: surviving a week together is not easy

Making It Happen Setting Up Your Charter

- Plan your trip
 - Get your crew
 - Boat type and size
- Contact charter companies
 - Price and terms
 - Responsiveness
- Make your arrangements
 - Charter agreement and resume
 - Deposits
 - Travel (passports, flights, hotels, trip insurance)
 - Charts and cruising guides (draft an itinerary)
 - Organize/prepare your crew

Making It Happen Provisioning Options

- Provision through your charter cor
 - Convenient
 - Generally more expensive
 - Usually end up with food left over
- Order ahead directly from supplied
 - Convenient
 - Usually less expensive than charter company
- Shop when you get there
 - More work
 - Usually least expensive option
 - See what you are buying

Provision for a few days and pick up more as you go



When You Get There

- Get to marina & check in with charter company
 - Complete your paperwork (cruising permits, return flights)
 - Security deposit
 - Other equipment (boat phone, dinghy locks, snorkel gear)
- Find your boat
- Attend chart briefing
- Boat briefing (Note: This is part of checking you out)
 - Boat systems & operation (check boat carefully; use checksheet)
 - Safety equipment
 - Dinghy & motor
 - Condition & inventory
- Load & stow provisions & gear on boat
- Brief crew & prepare to get underway

- *How to know if batteries are low
- *What to do if start battery is weak How and where to jump from
- *Y-valves where and how to set for:
 - pump out at sea 3 miles in USA & out of harbor in Canada
 - using free pump outs in USA

*Boat check out Priorities

- *Plan the night before get charting on your smartphone or tablet.
- *Agreed wakeup/start time procedure
- *Quit early mid pm to get guest slip or anchorage spot - the more popular and crowded, the earlier you must be there
- *Alone time for each couple
- *Mid week alone time plan

*Typical cruising day

End of Charter

- Return boat to charter company marina & check in with charter company
 - Refuel boat if required & Pump out Crapper tank
 - Clean up boat as necessary
 - Complete paperwork & boat check-in
 - Turn in boat phone, snorkel gear, dinghy locks, etc. as necessary
 - Check on transportation to hotel, ferry dock, or airport
- Tell charter company if anything is broken or missing
 - If they don't know it's broken or lost, they can't fix or replace it
 - Get signed a-ok and how does deposit come back?
- Have a beer or one last Painkiller
